

Terms and conditions of Bilingual Future Forum 2023

§ 1. General information

1. The organiser of the Bilingual Future Forum (hereinafter referred to as the Forum) is Centrum Inteligentnego Rozwoju S.C., based in Tychy at 23 Towarowa Street, REGON 363154124, NIP 646-294-01-37, hereinafter referred to as the Organiser.

3. The Forum will take place on 18th October 2023 at ApartHotel Temy Uniejów
4. These Regulations define the conditions for the organisation of and participation in the Forum and the services provided by the Organiser.
5. The Organiser is responsible for the entire content and logistics of the Forum.
6. The Organiser performs organisational, logistical and technical tasks at the Facility, either by itself or with the help of its subcontractors.
7. Before, during and after the Forum, organisational, logistical and technical tasks may be carried out by third parties, which are not subcontractors of the Organiser, only by parties with whom cooperation agreements will be concluded, under the terms and conditions specified by the Organiser.
8. Information about the Forum is available on the website www.bilingual.earth (hereinafter referred to as the Website).
9. All rights to the Website and its content belong to the Organiser. The Organiser is entitled to add, edit, change and delete any content posted on the Website, in part or whole.
10. The name of the Website, the logo, the principles of operation of the Website, all its graphic elements, the interface, as well as the software on which it is based, the code of the Website and the databases are subject to legal protection under the provisions of the Act of 4 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1191), the Act of 30 June 2000. - Industrial Property Law (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2017, item 776) and other mandatory legal regulations, including Community regulations.
11. The Forum's events will be recorded and the resulting photos and videos will be used for the Forum's promotional activities.

§ 2. Services provided electronically

1. Services are provided at all times, that is 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
2. As part of the services provided on the Website, the Organiser grants the Users free access to the Website and undertakes to maintain it without unnecessary interruption or downtime, with the exception of possible interruptions to the service due to the need for maintenance work, updates or caused by technical or IT problems.
3. Users agree to the terms and conditions of the Regulations. If Users do not accept the Terms and Conditions, they are not entitled to use the services of the Website.
4. A registration form service is provided free of charge on the Website to allow registration for participation in the Forum.
5. The use of the registration form service requires reading the Terms and Conditions and its acceptance.

§ 3. Conditions for participation in the Forum

1. The participation in the Forum is voluntary and open to all individuals who are at least 18 years of age and have full legal capacity or are at least 16 years of age and have obtained the consent of their parents or legal guardians to participate in the Forum, have registered and have an admission package to the Forum (hereinafter referred to as the package), in accordance with the regulations. The aforementioned individuals participating in the Forum are hereinafter referred to as Participants.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to verify the right of a given person to participate in the Forum by requesting the Participant to present an identity document or a document covering a statement of intent with regard to granting consent to the participation of a minor. If the Participant fails to present such a document immediately, the Organiser reserves the right to refuse such Participant's participation in the Forum until the relevant document is presented.
3. The participation in the Forum is free of charge. The number of participation packages is limited.
4. The participation packages are personal and cannot be sold or transferred. Each participation package entitles 1 (in words: one) person to enter the Forum and to be exchanged for one name badge.
5. In order to participate in the Forum, the Participant is required to register in person by completing the form available on the Website at: <https://irforum.conrego.com/>.
6. As part of the form, the potential Participant is required to provide the following data, including personal data (first name, surname, e-mail address, telephone number, position) and the data of the institution he or she represents (name of institution, street, building number, postal code, town, Tax Identification Number) hereinafter referred to as Personal Data.
7. Due to the need to ensure the safety and comfort of the Participants, the Organiser reserves the right to control and verify the Participant's identity and their entitlement to enter the facility or services related to the Forum, and the Participants agree to this.
8. The Organiser accepts that the Participant taking part in the Forum, accepts the possibility of the above mentioned recording and use of his/her silhouette or image as a participant in the Forum.
9. Personal data (e.g. image, voice during the lecture, name and surname) of a registered Forum Participant, in the form of a photographic/film/sound recording, may be processed for marketing, information, documentation purposes, etc. by the Organiser, in particular by placing personal data on the Internet, e.g. on the Organiser's website, on the Organiser's social networks/profiles, in the Organiser's printed marketing materials or through their transmission to other Forum participants in electronic/printed form, throughout the period of publication of such materials and throughout the period of information and marketing communication and documentation activities on the Internet.
10. In case of any doubts regarding the identity of a potential Participant or the data provided by the Participant (including personal data), the Organiser may require the Participant to produce a document proving their authenticity or identity.
11. In justified cases, in particular in the event of false or incomplete information, the Organiser may refuse to issue the Participant with a participation package or cancel the issued package.
12. Each Participant's application is subject to verification by the Organiser. The Organiser will inform the Participant of his/her qualification to participate in the Forum and provide confirmation of participation in electronic form to the e-mail address provided in the form.

§ 4. Special Rules for Participation in the Forum

1. The Organiser reserves the right to change the date of the Forum for reasons beyond their control. The Organiser agrees to inform the Participants about the changes by an email message sent to the Participant's address provided in the registration form. The change of the date of the Event does not constitute its cancellation.
2. The holder of the participation package receives a name badge on the day of the Forum, which entitles him/her to move around the Forum Facility. The Participant of the Forum is obliged to hold the name badge given to him/her at all times during his/her stay at the Facility and is obliged to show it each time requested by a representative of the Organiser. Only Participants with a name badge are allowed to enter the Forum Facility. Persons staying at the Facility who are unable to present their name badge at the request of a representative of the Organiser may be required to leave the Facility immediately. Persons who have lost or otherwise misplaced their personal identifier, upon verification of their identity by showing their ID, may be issued a duplicate.
3. The Forum will take place between 10.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. Staying in the Forum Venue outside this time slot is only permitted with the Organiser's permission.
4. Participants staying at the Facility are obliged to respect order and the rights of third parties. Participants are obliged to comply with health and safety rules and regulations safety and fire regulations in force on the premises of the Facility, as well as the instructions and organisational and technical orders of the Organiser's representatives. The documents indicated in this paragraph will be available for inspection during the Forum.
5. Aggressive persons, under the influence of alcohol or psychoactive substances will not be admitted to the Facility and, if discovered, such persons may be removed from the Forum Facility.
6. Own or third-party services are not permitted in the Facility unless the Organiser has given prior written consent.
7. The promotion of content not permitted by law or the rules of social interaction is prohibited in the Facility.
8. Recording, videotaping and photography are prohibited in the Facility without the written consent of the Organiser.
9. The Organiser reserves the right to remove any person violating the Rules from the Facility, without the right to return to the Facility or claim a refund of any costs or expenses incurred in connection with participation in the Forum, including the price paid for Partner Packages.
10. The Participant shall be obliged to cover all costs related to remedying the damage caused by him/her, sustained by the Organiser in connection with third parties making claims to the Organiser related to the damage caused by the Participant.
11. Any person holding a Forum name badge - with the word ORGANISER on it - is considered to be a representative of the Organiser during the Forum.

§ 5. Terms and conditions of the Forum partnership

1. The Organiser expects to cooperate in the organisation of the Forum with the Forum's Commercial Partners. The terms and conditions of the cooperation will be determined by an agreement concluded between the Organiser and the Forum Partner.
2. The Organiser also expects to cooperate with the Forum's Contents Partners in the organisation of the Forum.

3. The Organiser expects to cooperate in the organisation of the Forum with Forum Media Patrons. The terms of cooperation will be determined by an agreement between the Organiser and the Forum Media Patron.
4. A list of partner benefits for Commercial Partners is available with the Organiser.
5. The organisation of promotional events at the Facility is only possible through the Organiser, who offers these services on an exclusive basis.
6. The implementation of the development in the Facility, the additional services related to the implementation and the operation of the Partners' stands are carried out by the commercial Partners or their subcontractors according to the terms and conditions determined by the Organiser.
7. A price list of services is available at the Forum Organiser.

§ 6. Rules for dealing with the epidemic situation

1. In view of the epidemic state declared on the territory of the Republic of Poland as of 20 March 2020 in connection with SARS-CoV-2 virus infections, the Forum Participant is obliged to apply during the Forum the applicable regulations and guidelines of the relevant services, in particular: Regulation of the Council of Ministers on the establishment of certain restrictions, orders and prohibitions in connection with an epidemic state of 6 May 2021. (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 861), Regulation of the Minister of Health of 20 March 2020 on the declaration of a state of epidemic in the territory of the Republic of Poland (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 491), guidelines of the Chief Sanitary Inspector. Participants may move within the premises of the facilities only within publicly accessible and marked spaces and passageways, in accordance with the instructions of the Organiser and the Facility manager.
2. By registering for the Forum, the Participant acknowledges and accepts that participation in the Forum implies the potential arrival of the Participant among a large number of people, which consequently creates the possibility of spreading and exposing the Participant to contamination, in particular by viruses causing diseases, including the SARS CoV-2 virus, microorganisms or bacteria.
In view of the above risks, the Organiser provides Participants during the Forum with the safety measures indicated by the relevant services and the presence of doctors, but this does not eliminate the risk of negative health consequences, which are the responsibility of the Participant.
3. By registering for the Forum, the Participant agrees that his/her personal data indicated in the registration form may be communicated to the relevant services, in particular sanitary services. Consent is voluntary but necessary to participate in the Forum. The participant also acknowledges that he/she may be subject to temperature measurement and health verification.
4. The Participant is required to follow the procedure indicated below:
If the Participant develops worrying health symptoms such as, but not limited to, fever, cough, shortness of breath or breathing problems prior to entering the Facility, the Participant should not enter the Facility, should remain in his/her home or hotel where he/she is staying, should follow the recommendations of the Chief Sanitary Inspector and the Minister of Health and should immediately contact his/her doctor or district sanitary-epidemiological station, infectious department and, if his/her health condition worsens, call 999 or 112 and inform about the symptoms of illness.
If the Participant develops worrying health symptoms such as, but not limited to, fever, cough, shortness of breath or breathing problems during the Forum and the Participant's stay at the Facility, the Participant should immediately inform the Organiser and follow the recommendations of the Chief Sanitary Inspector and the Minister of Health and contact his/her

doctor or district sanitary-epidemiological station, infectious diseases unit immediately and in case of deterioration of health call 999 or 112 and inform about the symptoms of illness.

5. In the Facility, the Participant is obliged to use personal protective equipment - masks, disinfectant fluid, etc. according to the guidelines valid on the day of the Forum - at all times during the Forum, also during the discussion panels.

§ 7. Complaints

1. All complaints and claims related to the organisation and course of the Forum should be addressed to the Organiser at the address for correspondence: 23 Towarowa Street, 43-100 Tychy.
2. The Organiser is obliged to respond to the complaint within 30 days of its submission. If no answer is given within the aforementioned period, the complaint will be considered legitimate.

§ 8. Privacy Policy

1. By filling in the form, the Participant declares that the data provided is correct and consents to the processing of the Personal Data included in the form by the Organiser, for the purposes necessary for the implementation of the Forum. Participants' personal data is collected and processed for the purposes of the organisation and marketing activities of the Forum, in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Policy in force at the Organiser.
2. The Participant has the right to withdraw consent for the processing of Personal Data relating to him/her, to update, change, amend, supplement or request deletion, provided that such actions may prevent the Organiser from ensuring the Participant's participation in the Forum, in accordance with the Organiser's Personal Data Protection Policy.
3. As part of the functioning of the Website, the Organiser automatically collects and processes only the information contained in the cookies.
4. Cookies are understood to refer to, in accordance with Article 173 of the Telecommunications Act of 16 July 2004 (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1954), IT data (in particular text files) which are stored on the Website User's equipment and which are necessary or useful for the use of the Website. As a general rule, the aforementioned data is identified by a unique number and refers to the name of the website from which they originate and the time of their storage on the Website User's equipment.
5. The purpose of using cookies is:
 - (a) to adapt the content of the Website to the preferences of the Website User and to improve the use of the Website; in particular, the aforementioned IT data make it possible to recognise the Website User's device and to adapt the displayed website to his individual needs;
 - b) to organise and process data concerning the Website User's needs and use of the Website in order to improve its structure;
 - c) to maintain the session of a logged-in Website User (after logging in) without the need to log in again on the sub-pages of the Website.
6. The Website uses, in principle, two types of cookies: persistent cookies and session cookies. Persistent cookies remain on the Website User's equipment until they are deleted by the Website User, with the exception that the parameters of cookies provide a final expiry date. Session cookies are temporary in nature and are stored on the Website User's equipment until the Website is no longer in use (i.e. until the Website User logs off, leaves the Website website or switches off the software - Internet browser).

7. Most web browsers (software used to access websites) allow cookies to be stored on the Website user's device by default. Changing the settings in this respect is the sole responsibility of the Website user and may be done by him or her at any time, in particular by automatically blocking the use of cookies in the Website user's web browser settings. Detailed information on the handling of the aforementioned IT data is available in the settings of your Internet browser.
8. The Organiser informs you that the use of partial or full blocking of cookies may limit the availability of the services offered on the Website.
9. IT data placed on the Website user's device may be transmitted to contractors cooperating with the Organiser, including advertising and marketing purposes.
10. For further information on the above-mentioned IT data, please refer to the "Help" section in the menu of your Internet browser.

§ 9. Rules for the use of the Forum website

1. The User shall abstain from all activities that may hinder access to the Website by other Users and from activities that interfere with or prevent the functioning of the Website and the services provided as part of it and the conclusion of electronic contracts.
2. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any interference with the proper functioning of the Website, nor for any loss of data resulting from force majeure, unauthorised actions of third parties, or as a result of the Organiser's efforts to improve the functionality of the Website. The Organiser is obliged to inform in advance of any disruptions to the operation of the Website, in particular maintenance and technical interruptions.
3. The Organiser reserves that it is forbidden to place on the Website and in the form any unlawful content, in particular content inciting racial, ethnic or religious hatred, containing pornographic content, praising fascism, nazism, communism, propagating violence, offending religious feelings, violating the rights of others, etc.

§ 10. Application of the rules, liability of the Organiser, possibilities to change the agenda of the Forum, resolution of disputes and other regulations

1. By submitting the registration application on the form available on the Website, the Participant accepts the terms and conditions of these Rules and Conditions and undertakes to respect the rules of order and any other arrangements made between the Participant and the Organiser.
2. Failure to accept any of the rules will exclude participants from participating in the Forum.
3. The Organiser is not responsible for items lost or left by the Participant during the Forum at the Facility
4. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any damages caused to the Participant in connection with his/her participation in the Forum or his/her withdrawal from participation in the Forum. In particular, the Organiser shall not be responsible for the Participant's inability to participate in the Forum caused by force majeure or for reasons on the part of the Participant.
5. In the event that the Forum does not take place for reasons beyond the Organiser's control, the Participant shall not be entitled to compensation or to refund of any fees related to the planned participation in the Forum incurred by the Participant. In any situation, to the extent permitted by law, the Organiser shall not be obliged to refund any costs related to the Forum incurred by the Participant other than through the Organiser.
6. The organiser sets the programme of the Forum and has the right to make changes to it, also on the day on which the Forum takes place, including the right to change the time schedule, the order of speeches and to change the speakers. The Organiser will inform Participants of each change on the Website.

7. A Participant who is a consumer has the possibility to use out-of-court complaints and claims. Detailed information concerning the possibility for a Participant who is a consumer to use out-of-court ways of dealing with complaints and pursuing claims, as well as rules of access to these procedures, are available at the offices and websites of district (city) consumer advocates, social organisations whose statutory tasks include consumer protection, Provincial Commercial Inspection Inspectorates and the website of the Office of Competition and Consumer Protection (www.uokik.gov.pl). A participant who is a consumer may use the platform for online dispute resolution (ODR) available at <http://ec.europa.eu/consumers/odr/>. In matters not covered by these Regulations, the rules of Polish law shall apply.
8. The competent court for any disputes arising in connection with the signing or performance of the agreement concluded with the Participant shall be the court having jurisdiction over the registered office of the Organiser.
9. This version of the Regulations shall enter into force on 22 June 2022.
10. The Regulations are available on the Organiser's Website as well as at the Organiser's registered office.
